

**An Ordinance Regulating the Consumption and Possession of  
Intoxicating Beverages in County Owned Buildings, County Owned  
Recreation Facilities, and County owned Property**

In accordance with N.C.G.S 153A-121 and N.C.G.S 18B-300, it shall be unlawful for any person to drink, possess, or otherwise consume or attempt to drink or otherwise consume or to aid and abet others in drinking or otherwise consuming any malt beverage, wine or other intoxicating liquor in any county-owned building, county-owned property, or county-owned recreation facilities.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined not more than \$ 50.00 or imprisoned for not more than 30 days.

Effective Date:

This ordinance was adopted by the McDowell County Board of Commissioners and shall take effect and be in force on September 13th, 2010.
